PROGRAM

1. TRAINING

Tailor-made training, aimed to improve knowledge and skills.

2. DEVELOPMENT OF IMPLEMENTATION PLAN

In group and individual support during the development of the implementation plan.

3. OPERATIONALIZATION OF THE IMPLEMENTATION

Individual support during the actual implementation of the plan.



SUPPORT

In group and personal training and advice on implementation.

Financial support for external training.

Financial support (max €30,000) to develop and implement the plan on a small scale.
